General Manager Report:

8.1 **Maintenance -Mr. Villalpando-** our mower is not working we have it a BSE trying to get a new deck fabricated cause the deck that we have now they don't make any more they are going to do what they can to get it repaired, meanwhile we found a rental, we have also opened up the tennis court to the public, and we have been on top of the graffiti at Weedpatch Park, I also have the estimate for the restrooms provided to you Mr. Rodriguez- is it only one estimate that you got Mr. Villalpando- yes only one estimate but I will provide two more and in the pool we have an issue with the eco box not allowing to read the chemicals correctly, I reached out to our previous maintenance supervisor to make sure everything was been done correctly and he suggested to have Knorr Pool come out and already set up a meeting with them next week and I'm going to have the eco box checked out as well Mrs. Loza- on the mower is that monthly Mr. Villalpando- no that's as needed we are trying to cut back on the water so it doesn't grow so much Mrs. Loza- and the mower that you have in the shop is it an old one Mr. Villalpando- yes we have had it along time and been having a lot of issues with it Mr. Rodriguez- I noticed that you got rid of that old van at the Arvin Pool Mr. Villalpando- yes it looks better it was an eye sore Mr. Rodriguez- I noticed that the small fence in the pool area has been tore down ad there's and there is a big hole on the south side of the bleachers, how long has that been like that Mr. Villalpando- I have tried to knot it up as best as I can but they just keep tearing it up, we have people camping out in the front I think it might be them cutting it up and going inside the pool to shower in there Mr. Rodriguez- that hole needs to get fixed we don't want kids going in the pool Mr. Villalpando- I will take care of it Mr. Rodriguez- and that trailer is an eye sore too is there any possible way to contact the City of Arvin the have a lot of areas that you can park it Mrs. Lozawhen I've gone by the park there's like ten homeless people out there Mr.

Villalpando- there's people out there as well giving out food and they got permission from the city of Arvin to do that

Recreation- Mrs. Gonzalez- for Jr. Giants we have 171 kids registered our 8.2 registration ends at the end of next month and we are having a senior division this year, I'm currently working on registrations online, hopefully by September we start registrations online, and I have been doing research on a batting cage Mr. Perez-how many bats and balls do we have do we have more than 100 Mrs. Gonzalez- no we have around 60 to 70 bats and we have a lot as helmets as well, this will be an awesome and a good way to generate money, we can start of small we can start up at Arvin first Mr. Perez- will 40 thousand cover both Arvin and Lamont Mrs. Gonzalez- no it will only cover one site Mrs. Loza- how much would you charge Mrs. Gonzalez- I did a little bit of research and they charge \$1 for 13 balls and Mr. Villalpando had seen that they have \$5 for 30 minutes Mr. Perez- I would really encourage that this item to be discussed Mrs. Cervantes- they have already damaged the Tennis Court Mr. Villalpando- it's from people hanging on the net Mr. Alonsohow bad did you say it was Mr. Villalpando- right now is just a slit lean on it I gave it a push to see how much it's going to hold Mr. Alonso- you've seen people hanging om it Mr. Villalpando – no I haven't seen but with what I have seen on the playground it looks similar Mr. Alonso – question for District Counsel in what point do we feel that we need to take it down before it becomes a liability Mr. Hodges-I don't know what it look like so unless it's going to collapse and hurt someone
